

Activities of AIDP Chilean National Group through 2023-2024

1. During this period, the Board of Directors of the Chilean group has held periodic meetings in accordance with the provisions of its bylaws.
2. Various steps have been taken before the Chilean administrative authorities in order to regularize and update the operation of the Chilean Group as a formal organization (Asociación Gremial), mainly in order to register with the authorities the update of the statute approved in 2023 and the new composition of the board of directors.
3. On June 6, 2024, the Chilean Seminar in Preparation for Doha 2024, "AI and Penal Law" was held in the Supreme Court building in Santiago. It was attended by associates and professors Soledad Krause, Juan Carlos Manríquez and Gonzalo Rodríguez. In addition, Ana María Morales, Manager of the Studies Division of the National Prosecutor's Office, also participated as a speaker. The main objective of the seminar was to present the conclusions of the preparatory meetings for Paris 2024, which took place in 2023 in Buenos Aires and Bucharest, and in which our associates Juan Carlos Manríquez, Gonzalo Rodríguez and Soledad Krause had a prominent participation.
4. In June 2023, our partner Yamil Yuivar, participated in the 22nd specialization course in International Criminal Law, at the Siracusa International Institute for Criminal Justice and Human Rights, in person in Syracuse, Italy. The topic of the course was "75 Years: The Universal Declaration of Human Rights and The Genocide Convention".
5. On October 5, 2023, the Extraordinary Assembly of Members was held in the city of Santiago, an instance in which the activities of the Chilean Group during the period 2023 were reported.
6. In 2024 activities were resumed with participation of some members of our group in monthly criminal law update seminar held at the Supreme Court of Chile, led by our president of the Chilean Group Mr. Jean Pierre Matus Acuña.
7. More than 10 new members joined the Chilean Group in this period.
