

# **Chinese National Group Annual Report 2023-2024**

## **I. AIDP Election and Members**

On 31 January 2024, the AIDP China Group had held the general meeting and elected the new president, vice presidents and also members of the council. Prof. Wang Xiumei has been elected new president of AIDP China Group. Up to 18 June 2024, the Chinese National Group has nearly 184 members, and most of them are professors and researchers from universities and some of them are judges, prosecutors and lawyers, who have made remarkable achievements in penal justice practices.

## **II. Membership**

1. Individuals: For the 2024, according to the statistics of the secretariat of Chinese Group, 117 Chinese members have made their annual membership contribution (in total 5580 Euros) to AIDP. Besides, 8 Chinese students of BNU enrolled for Siracusa Institute Courses 2024 as young penalists and they also paid their membership fees together with course fees.

2. Chinese Group fee: The secretariat of Chinese Group has also assisted China Law Society in transferring the membership fees (110 Euros) of National Group to AIDP.

## **III. Conference and Activities**

1. From 27 May to 7 June 2024, we have organized 8 students from law school of BNU to attend the 23rd Specialization Course in International Criminal Law for Young Penalists on “International Criminal Law and Current Global Crises” online.

2. Since April 2024, we have been preparing for a delegation to attend the XXIst International Congress of the International Association of Penal Law which will be held in Paris, France.
3. On 11-12 November 2023, we have hold the 7<sup>th</sup> International Forum on the topic of “International Cooperation and Denying of Safe Haven to Corruption” in Shanghai. More than 150 experts and scholars from China, the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, the International Association of Penal Law, Northeastern University of the United States, the University of Rio de Janeiro in Brazil, the University of Salono in Italy, Georgia New Horizon University, Cambridge University in the United Kingdom and other countries and regions attended the forum in person and online.
4. On November 23, 2023, the 40th session of the BNU Anti-corruption Forum was successfully held at Beijing Normal University. This lecture is delivered by Prof. Cássius Chai, an organized crime prosecutor from the state of Marañion, Brazil. The theme of the lecture is “Combating Cross-border Corruption: Strengthening the Anti-Corruption Framework of BRICS Countries”.
5. On November 22, 2023, the 39th session of the BNU Anti-Corruption Forum was successfully held at Beijing Normal University. This lecture is delivered by Prof. Thomas Kruessmann from Georgia New Horizon University. The theme of the lecture is “Dangerous Signals: How to Control Corruption Risks in the Supply Chain”.
6. On November 8, 2023, the 37th session of the BNU Anti-Corruption Forum

was successfully held at Beijing Normal University. This lecture is delivered by Prof. Barry Alexander Kenneth Reed, Honorary Senior Professor at the Development Research Center of Cambridge University. The theme of the lecture is "New Strategies for Dealing with Financial and Economic Crime."

7. On September 28, 2023, the 36<sup>th</sup> BNU Anti-Corruption Forum was successfully held at Beijing Normal University. This lecture is led by Prof. Hans-Joerg Albrecht, former director of the Max Planck Institute for Crime, Security and Law in Germany. The theme of the lecture is "Preventing and Monitoring Corruption".
8. On 17-18 August 2023, the 14th "Contemporary Criminal Justice Forum" was successfully held at the Gao Mingxuan Academic Museum in Yuhuan City, Zhejiang Province. The forum is themed "Criminal Law Governance in the Era of Misdemeanor".
9. On 19-20 August 2023, the 21<sup>st</sup> China- Korea International Symposium on Criminal Law was successfully held at the Gao Mingxuan Academic Museum in Yuhuan City, Zhejiang Province. The topic of the conference was "Research on Unit Crime and Corporate Compliance in Criminal Cases".
10. From 12 to 17 June 2023, we have organized 10 students from law school of BNU to attend the Siracusa "22nd Specialization Course in International Criminal Law for Young Penalists 'M. Cherif Bassiouni' 75 YEARS: THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND THE GENOCIDE CONVENTION" online.
